



Multiactivity Adventure on Lake Titikaka Day by day description

Day 1 LLACHON

On arrival in Llachon by way of road transport or boat (on your own or you can request a pick-up at Puno or Juliaca) settle into your rural lodge. In the afternoon we will take a short hike into the village and become familiar with our surroundings. We will also receive a short briefing on next day's sea kayaking trip getting all our equipment ready. Afternoon excursion to Uros Island in the vicinity of Llachon, overnight and dinner.

Day 2 LLACHON / TIKONATA

Leaving early from our beach by sea-kayak we will start the day hugging the shoreline along the Capa Chica Peninsula until we reach the point. Continuing along the shore we then cross the bay of Cotos, round the second point and continue along the shore until reaching the island of Tikonata. Along the way we will stop for picnic lunch at a beach or using our support boat as a base. At the island we disembark and stay at a local rural lodge with a chance to hike around the island and its beautiful ambiance. Tikonata is uninhabited mostly, only at a certain time of year, do people come to harvest from across the bay. (Sea kayaking: 4 hours).

Day 3 TIKONATA / CHIFRON / LLACHON

Loading our sea-kayaks and support equipment onto our support boat we head to the mainland dock at Chifron, a sandy bay with a nice beach. Here our bicycles will wait for us. We harness up and begin about a four hour ride to Llachon, stopping for a typical lunch along the way. We reach Llachon in the early afternoon, relax and overnight at our lodge.

Day 4 LLACHON / TAQUILE / PUNO

Today we get on a local sailboat for the first leg of the journey, until reaching the top of the Peninsula of Capa Chica. Here we transfer to a motor-boat and continue to Taquile, where we arrive before the crowds. We hike up the island before most tourists arrive, visit the main square and do a hike to the southern trip of the island. Here we get picked up and return to Llachon, where a vehicle will pick us up to head back to Puno overland. (optional return by boat for the same price directly to Puno from Taquile). Overnight at hotel, dinner not included.

Day 5 PUNO / ONWARDS

After breakfast we drive through the town, visit the Yavari, an iron - hulled museum ship and head towards Juliaca (or La Paz), depending in your onward connection.



SERVICES INCLUDED: Sea-kayaks, paddles, life jackets and safety equipment; mountain bicycles and helmets, a local guide and all meals including overnights in rural lodges. Boat transportation to Taquile and back or onto Puno as well as transportation overland to Puno.

SERVICES NOT INCLUDED: Transportation to Llachon, gloves, sun screen, hats, alcoholic beverages, personal clothing, extras, and insurance, camera gear, toiletries.
